Dear Applicant:

Attached is a copy of the application form for the Royal Oak PTA Council's ***Donald M. Currie Memorial Scholarship***. This year, eight (8) \$500.00 scholarships will be awarded to seniors at Royal Oak High School or Churchill Community High School (Daytime Alternative High School students only).

Due to the nature of scholarships and the excellence they represent, we ask that you fill in the application accurately and carefully. **PLEASE DO NOT WRITE** your name anywhere in the application materials except where indicated on the application. In addition to your completed application, please include:

- At least one (1) letter of recommendation from a significant adult in your life (other than a family member). This would be considered a character reference and would add support to your application.
- A **typed** essay of **250 words or less**. Handwritten essays and essays exceeding 250 words will not be accepted. You must also indicate which school you attend in the appropriate places. The applications are to be turned into the counselor's office by **Monday, April 22, 2019**.

Each of our Royal Oak School PTAs contribute to the funding of the scholarships. Seniors who currently attend Royal Oak public schools and will attend an accredited college, university, or trade school in the fall of the scholarship year, are eligible to apply for the Royal Oak PTA Donald M. Currie Memorial Scholarship. Applicants are judged on academics, character, extracurricular activities within school and the community, volunteer or paid work experience, and financial need.

The committee is comprised of PTA parent representatives, one from each of the Royal Oak schools who evaluate all applications received, using a scoring of 1-100. Applicant names are hidden from the applications prior to distribution to the representatives. This year, the students receiving the eight highest scored applications are being awarded scholarships in the amount of \$500 each. In addition, this application will be scored with a focus on service and community activity for one of two \$500 scholarships from the Royal Oak Education Foundation.

All scholarship recipients will be announced and recognized at the Churchill High School Graduation on Thursday, May 16th or the Senior Convocation Program on Tuesday, May 21st. Recipients will be notified of the award prior to receiving the award.
